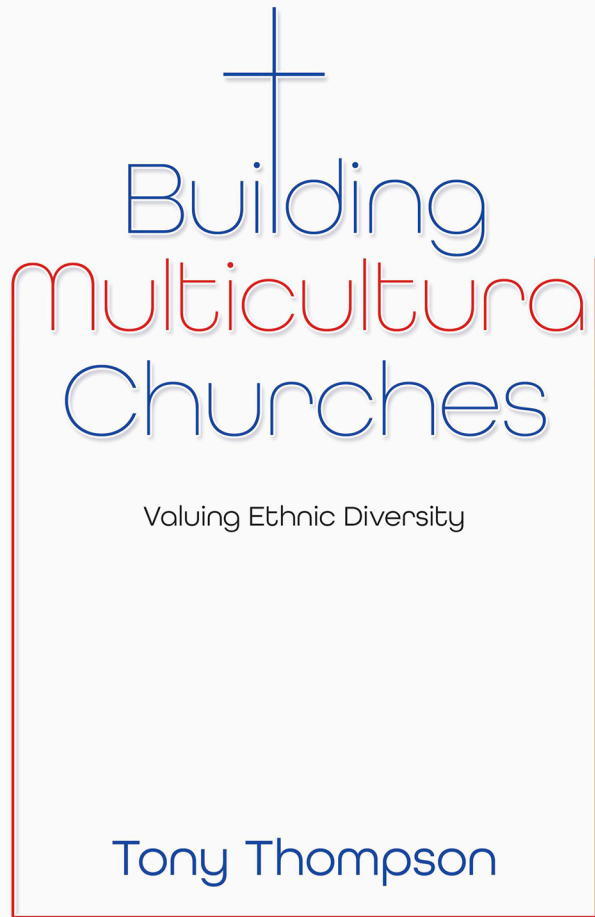


Building Multicultural Churches

He emphasises that unity in Christ celebrates differences rather than erases them, challenging churches to break down barriers of ethnicity, culture, and class as envisioned in Scripture.
- Rejecting claims that engaging in diversity is merely 'woke', Thompson urges Christians to reclaim the biblical mandate for reconciliation and unity. Incorporating global perspectives, he highlights the importance of learning from diverse voices to build inclusive, gospel-centred communities.
